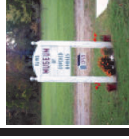

# Olin's Museum of Covered Bridges



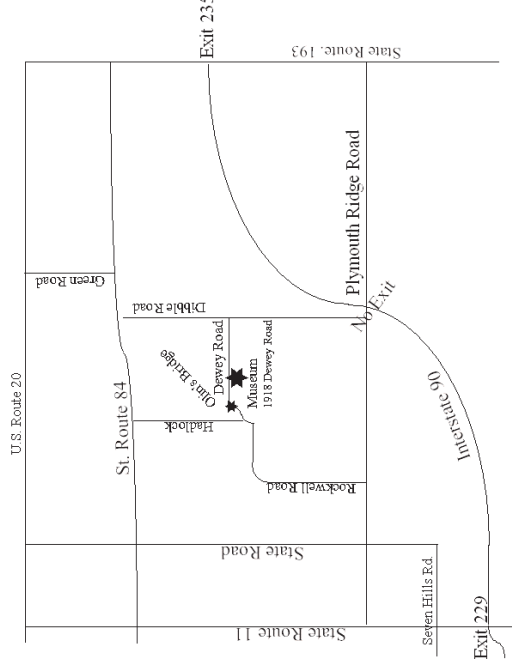
**Directions from Cleveland:** Take 90 East to Route 11 North. Take the Seven Hills Road Exit and travel East on Seven Hills Road. Turn North on State Road. Turn East on Plymouth Ridge Road. Turn left at Rockwell Road. Take Rockwell Road to Dewey Road (going to the right and down the hill at the "Y" in the road). The museum is the second drive on the right past Olin's Bridge.

**Directions from Erie:** Take Interstate 90 West to exit 235. Turn North on Route 193. Go to the first stoplight, which is Route 84 and turn West. Turn South on Dibble Road. Go 1 1/4 miles then turn right on Dewey Road. The museum is one mile down on the left hand side of the road, before Olin's covered Bridge.

Located within walking distance just east of Olin's covered bridge on Dewey Road, the museum is owned and operated by members of the Olin family.
